MEETING MINUTES
Meeting Date: February 17, 2022

President Brower opened the meeting.

1. Jessica Hartman gave an oral address to the Golf Committee to reverse her suspension. Mrs. Hartman was advised she would receive a decision within a few days.
2. Golf Course Open Items—Juan:
 - a. Coots—tabled until next Fall.
 - i. Time has passed for our federal permit application to be approved; HOA will reapply when appropriate.
 - ii. Falconry was suggested as a way to remove coots.
3. Golf Course New Business
 - a. GC Maintenance is installing drains throughout the course where drainage is poor.
4. Treasurer Report:
 - a. February 17, 2022 cash on hand—\$1,458.00 and cash in the bank--\$3,402.75; Hole-in-One Pool is at \$135.00.
5. Committee Open Items:
 - a. Sign/sandwich board at hole #1 tee box to convey the use of the course during weekly tournament play—request cancelled; GM will not permit it.
6. Tournament Chair Report:
 - a. Valentine Red Tee Tournament was a success.
 - b. March Madness Best Ball Tournament flyer will be posted in SCH.
 - c. 2023 Club Championship will be an 36-hole, 2-day Tournament with all teams starting on Hole #1. Groups will be organized by Tournament Director.
7. Social Director Report:
 - a. March Madness Tournament—each golfer gets one free drink.
 - b. Championship Tournament Banquet—research provider for BBQ or something else.
 - i. MCH has been reserved for two hours April 1, 2022, for setup.
 - ii. MCH has been reserved the afternoon of April 3, 2022, for the banquet.

8. Handicap/Rules

- a. The Golf Club has tested golfsoftware.com online handicap system and voted earlier in the month to switch to that company for all our handicapping needs.
- b. Enrollment in the program is mandatory to play in any/all RCRVR Golf Club Tournaments; this will be announced to golfers at all upcoming tournaments as well as an email from the HOA Office to Owners and Renters.
- c. The cost per golfer for calendar year will be discussed.
- d. Effective 2/19/22 golfers will not be able to post scores to the old golf computer any longer.
- e. Effective March 1, 2023 and going forward, all handicaps will come from the new system. Handicaps will update automatically and golfers will use their "at-the-moment" handicap for each RCRVR Tournament.
- f. An electrical outlet will be installed in the golf closet for the chromebook and printer

- a. Handicap/Rules Committee will review and revise RCRVR Handicap Policy and RCRVR Rules and present to Golf Committee for review and approval
