Hole-In-One Pool Policy

The Hole-In-One Pool is for a hole-in-one (HIO) during any of the Golf Club Board sanctioned tournaments. To win the HIO Pool, the Player must be in a scheduled RCRVR Golf Club tournament, have paid the entry fee, and have at least one competitor. Tournaments that are eligible for a HIO payout are the Monday Blue Course, Women's Wednesday, Men's Thursday, Saturday Scramble, Chapman, Match Play, and Club Championship.

Special note for events requiring a phantom player: A HIO by a phantom player's ball does not qualify for payout. The phantom ball is the second ball the player playing the phantom hits off the tee.

The entry fee to get into the HIO pool is \$5.00. Once the pool is paid out for a hole-in-one during a sanctioned tournament then the pool starts over again.

In the unlikely event that multiple players have a HIO on the same day, those players will share the pool equally.

The Golfer that gets a HIO during a sanctioned tournament must notify the Club's Treasurer and provide the name of witnesses who can verify the HIO.

The Club Treasure will maintain the HIO pool and provide information to Club members regarding the pool.
